

### Key Features

- Ask questions about patient subsets, based on category or location or diagnosis.
- Search for a particular HLA type.
- Select sample statistics for administrative reports.
- Export these text files to another database, to a spreadsheet, or to presentation software.
- Set up query templates if you need the same information again and again, but for a different date range. ...and more

The Ad Hoc Query Function Module is a powerful database search tool. Ask any question about your patients or your workload or your test results and GET the ANSWER!!

1. Create a query template using the 'new' icon and give it a name. You'll probably use this template periodically.
2. Select the 'Sample', 'Test', and 'Provider' fields that will give you the desired search results.
3. Use a 'filter' tool to better define each field.
4. Press 'execute' and see a list of the data you were looking for.
5. Select all or some of the list.
6. Export this selection to a text file and name the file.
7. Print the list for reference at a later time.
8. Create as many templates as you need to answer your questions and prepare for reports.
